### STAAR/EOC Testing News

Visitors to the [TMIP website](#) will notice that new forms and information for Out-of-State STAAR/EOC testing have been posted to the website. Specifically, users will see the new Migratory Student STAAR/EOC Referral form, General Security Oath, seating chart, and TMIP Test Administrator Information.

TMIP encourages all MEP staff to contact their migratory families about any potential upcoming moves. If a family will be in a different region of Texas or out-of-state during the upcoming testing window, MEP staff are encouraged to complete the [Migratory Student STAAR/EOC Testing Referral Form](#). TMIP staff will review the forms, follow-up if needed, and coordinate testing for the students while they are away from their homebase school district.

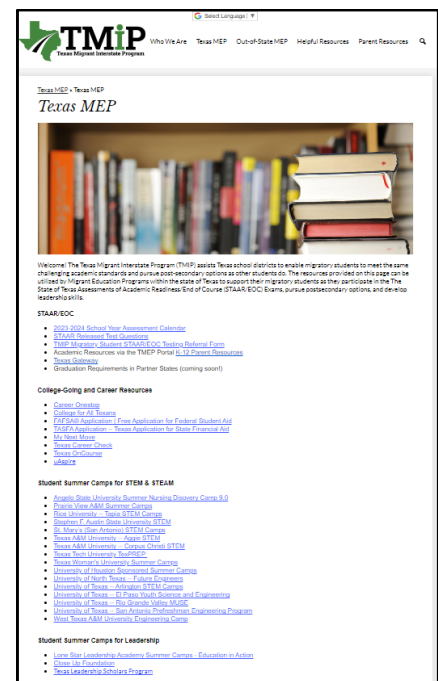
All testing will be conducted online, and priority for testing will be given to 12th grade migratory students who are retesting to meet [Texas Graduation Requirements](#). Of course, TMIP will also help coordinate testing for other migratory students (OSY, high school re-testers, first-time testing, etc.).

### Summer Resources

Summer is an important time for MEP staff to support migratory children in their area. Providing support lessons, enrichment activities, and opportunities for leadership development can not only prevent the proverbial “summer slide”, but also keep children engaged in academic learning.
